Congratulations to Governor Scott Walker and his recall victory in Wisconsin earlier this month.

Peggy Noonan wrote a great article in the Wall Street Journal recently talking about this victory and the right of Union Workers in the Public Sector to withdraw from the Union for whatever reason. As a result, the public union members there have dropped from about 62,000 to only 26,000.
