I was debating to speak out on the executive orders that President Obama has issued in the last three and a half years and decided against it until he issued his most recent executive order stating that Attorney General Eric Holder would not have to release any more documents to Congress. Well you know what Congress did, the committee that was overseeing this matter has recommended that the matter go to the full House for a contempt citation. ~~The vote was along party lines, 23 to 17.~~

The executive order that was just prior to this one was the amnesty program that was adopted by President Obama's executive order. According to John Morton, Director of Immigration and Customs Enforcement, the policy will now direct Border Patrol agents not to enforce immigration laws. President Obama has made more executive orders than any previous president in history. The number of executive orders equals twenty two a month, which is at least one for every working business day.

In an article in the Washington Times and in the National News, it was reported that President Barack Obama signed the National Defense Resources Preparedness executive order handing over, in times of peace and national crisis, control of all American resources to the President of the United States.
